\_\_\_\_\_ **Affiliate Committee:** To provide Affiliate members an opportunity to serve the Association membership and be recognized for their efforts. The objectives is to gather the collective talents of the Affiliates to assist other Committees, to organize and promote social and educational activities not already addressed by other Committees, and to allow Affiliate members to interact with each other in the spirit of better business relations.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Borpac/Impac:** These trustees make decisions based on where to spend the Political Action Funds that are requested from various entities. (i.e. candidate campaigns, issue campaigns, etc.) You must have contributed to the Political Action Fund in order to sit on this committee.

\_\_\_\_\_ **CCRMLS:** Responsible for recommending continued improvements of the MLS through the Central Coast Multiple Listing Service to our Board of Directors. Reviews computerized data, MLS Rules and Regulations and procedures, MLS security and recommends suggested improvements to the Board of Directors.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Education:** Provides informative current classes for our REALTOR® membership.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Equal Opportunity/Cultural Diversity:** The mission of the committee is to, in conjunction with local Boards of REALTORS®, design, promote and implement the Association's programs in the areas of minority outreach, fair housing, affirmative marketing, fair lending practices, and cultural awareness. The committee also monitors and evaluates legislative, legal and regulatory trends in issue areas related to equal access to shelter for all individuals. The committee is a work committee and reports to the Executive Committee and the Board of Directors.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Event Committee:** Plans and executes fundraising events for the association (ex: Chili Cookoff), and coordinates the Annual Installation and Election of Officers and Directors Event, in addition to any other social event that may present itself, making sure to include any necessary additional committees.

\_\_\_\_\_ **GAD/Local Government Relations:** Monitors local government regarding real estate related issues. Attends local city council, and county board of supervisor meetings, and can be involved in other strategic committees, workshops and task forces related to real estate development and growth. Mobilization of membership and reporting to the membership regarding these issues is a major component of this committee.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Green House Effects:** Our "green" committee. Plans and executes the Eco-Expo, and organizes and promotes effective green REALTOR® lifestyles.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Grievance:** Reviews complaints from the membership and the public regarding violations of the Code of Ethics and MLS and makes recommendations as to their disposition. \* Must attend Professional Standards Training that is provided by the association.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Nominating:** The Nominating Committee shall select one candidate for each office and one candidate for each place to be filled on the Board of Directors.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Professional Standards:** Enforces the Code of Ethics of the National Assn. of REALTORS® and conducts ethics and arbitration hearings as referred by the Grievance Committee of the Association. \* Must attend Professional Standards Training that is provided by the association.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Strategic Planning:** To assure the most effective and efficient allocation of Association resources. This committee develops a strategic long range plan to be reviewed annually which focuses on results to be achieved, ties activities to objectives, highlights trade-offs of alternative courses of action, and equips the Association to deal with contingencies.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Technology:** Sponsor, develop and promote opportunities to educate the membership in computer technology at affordable prices to benefit the member, the client and the community. Makes recommendations and suggestions regarding the Association Website. Educates, investigates and promotes technology for our Association membership.
